All items (application, images, bio, resume, portfolio) must reach the committee no later than **APRIL 15th 2014**. All artwork sent for consideration must be work that represents the exhibit theme of ART AND DEMOCRACY. Please include a brief of the artwork submitted and a detailed description of medium and dimensions.

Successful applicants will be notified by **May 1st 2014** And will be provided a contract that details terms and conditions. Successful applicants will be encouraged to attend all events and the opening ceremony held on **May 24th 2014**.
